Four 1st Placements, one 3rd Placement, Rally Advanced Title

Border Collie "2B" debuted in obedience classes at the Orlando DTC on April 4 & 5 and finished her second rally title. She had turned two years old on April 2nd, 2015. She is now **Rival's Meant 2B Jenny RA!** Yay Toobs!

Saturday she earned 3rd Place for her Rally Advanced title leg and returned Sunday for a insurance leg with a 1st Place. I would have moved her up to Excellent but her runs would have conflicted with **Vhari's UDX class runs**. So, I figured no point in adding more chaos, she could stay in advanced for one more day.

Saturday she ran in Wild Card Novice and earned a 1st Place, Sunday she earned 2nd Place in Wild Card Novice. Saturday she showed in Graduate Novice and did a nice job but I did not take her back in for groups because it was her first obedience experiences that day and some of the dogs looked like they may not stay in the long down. Sunday, the dogs appeared more calm and she did the class and the groups and won 1st Place Graduate Novice. 2B also ran in Wild Card Open and she did a nice job on all of the exercises except one return over the high where she went around. I declined groups for both days but I was able to test drive her Novice & Open skills in the distraction of a real trial and it was a good experience for her. All in all her heeling held up well under trial stress for five heeling patterns a day she wasn't always perfect but she knew her job and didn't bark at anyone while inside the ring working. At least there is good progress.



34th UDX Leg for Vhari

Border Collie Vhari, earned two more qualifier legs in Open B for the Classic (194.5 & 195.5) and a 34th UDX leg on Sunday! We did agility the weekend before so it was hard to switch gears but we'll keep working on it.

Three 1st Place & one 2nd Place AKC Agility Trial

The Eslinger Border Collies did well at Palmetto. 2B was entered in her first agility trial the weekend before her second birthday (and the weekend right before her first obedience trial classes at ODTc). She earned a Nov JWW leg with a clean run. Her Mum, Vhari earned an Open Std leg with a 2nd Place. Aunt Lizzie earned two 1st Place Novice Std legs, one clean run. Their Mother was exhausted from running all three! But it was very rewarding seeing them have so much fun but still be so well behaved holding perfect start line stays, getting contacts and their weaves. Now we just need to perfect our handling so we don't have wrong courses/refusals. Most of the time they just had one too many and that flummoxed the run. Lots to practice!
